

Leadership planning construction of Walking Trail at Weinert Elementary

The members of Leadership Seguin 2008-2009 have announced that their group project is to construct a walking trail at Weinert Elementary School.

The walking trail will be 400 meters long and 6 feet wide. The final product would be the kick-off to a major town project that will eventually connect walking trails to develop a loop around Seguin. The Leadership Seguin project completion is expected to be May 2009. The goals of the walking trail project are to combat obesity, prevent disease, educate the community about physical fitness, and meet or exceed the state guidelines for fitness.

To raise the money to build the walking trail, Leadership Seguin's fundraising efforts include constructing and raffling a playhouse with the assistance of Sheriff Arnold Zwicke,

and in the spring, they are planning events to market city-wide participation in a volleyball tournament and a walk/run in Seguin to promote health and also promote the new walking trail. The group also has food-related fundraising ideas in the making! Be on the lookout for our promotions and announcements on these events in the newspaper and on the radio. Dates are TBA.
